The Saskatoon Industry-Education Council (SIEC) is excited to announce an opportunity for youth to experience the automotive industry. The SIEC Automotive Skills Boot Camp provides students the chance to gain a better understanding of automotive service, maintenance and repair. Students will engage in independent learning as well as a number of hands-on activities led by a journey person mechanic. Students in the Automotive Skills Boot Camp must be motivated to complete work on their own time, and be willing to work in a group setting.

The camp will benefit students in a number of ways, including:

- Receiving hands-on instruction from a journey person during hands-on activities.
- Safety Construction Orientation Training facilitated by the SIEC.
- An opportunity to meet new friends; friends they will work with throughout the program.

The Automotive Skills Boot Camp is for students currently in grade 10, 11, or 12 who may be showing an interest in a career in the automotive industry.
