### **Equipment & Supplies**

- Accepted students under 18 will need a parent signature on equipment deposit contract. This will be provided with acceptance letter.

This boot camp will accept 12 students; please complete and send in your application by emailing to the SIEC office before the **deadline of Thursday, April 1, 2021**. The Hairstyling & Esthetics Skills Boot Camp is open to students in grades 10, 11 and 12.
